- Faculty will give game instructions to their team rather than using the PA for announcements. All the game descriptions are included. Strategize appropriately. Please avoid duplicating students; try to get as much participation as possible.
- Scoring: For all games, 1<sup>st</sup> = 1 pt; 2<sup>nd</sup> = 2 pts; 3<sup>rd</sup> = 3 pts; 4<sup>th</sup> = 4 pts; 5<sup>th</sup> = 5 pts; and 6<sup>th</sup> = 6 pts. Low score wins the assembly

  - Scoring: Elder
- “**Eat It**” – the grade who wins a game will get a snack before the next game; runners up will snack if repeat winners

# The Games

## Game #1: WRAP-IT (Area W)

*Object:* Wrap the empty boxes

*Number of students per grade:* 4

*Supplies per grade:*

- 4 empty boxes
- 1 banquet table
- 4 rolls of wrapping paper
- 2 rolls tape
- 3 children's scissors
- 1 roll ribbon

*Instructions:*

Students must wrap each box separately. You choose what materials to use; you don't need to use everything. Keep all supplies at the table—you will need them later. Time limit: 12 minutes. During the wrapping game, please give directions and choose the students for the remaining games. We will overlap to conserve time.

*Scoring* will be based 1/3 on quickness, 2/3 on quality of wrapping. Judges: Mrs. Greenawalt, Mrs. Hepler, & Mrs. Smith.

## Game #2: SING-IT (Area S)

*Object:* Name that Christmas Carol

*Number of students per grade:* 1

*Supplies per grade*

- 1 desk/table for buzzer
- 1 "buzzer"
- piano

*Instructions:*

Students must name the Christmas carol as the song is played. The music will stop once the first student buzzes. Student must wait until called upon before naming the song.

*Scoring:* Most correct answers wins. No tie breakers.

**Game #3: SPIN IT, THEN DECK IT (Area ▲)**

*Object:* Tinsel the tree

*Number of Students per grade:* 6

*Supplies per grade*

- 4 cardboard tubes from wrapping paper
- 2 strands garland

*Instructions:*

Four students, each with a tube, sit facing each other. Hold the tubes to form a “tree” (teepee). The remaining two students, one at a time, will spin in place for 12 revolutions. Teacher will count. They will open the garland, attach one end to a “branch”, and deck the tree. Once complete, the second student may begin to spin. Repeat.

*Scoring:* Timed, based on both strands wrapped around the tree

**Game #4: CARRY IT. (Area ©) If time is a problem, we skip this game.**

*Object:* Relay race with wrapped packages

*Number of students per grade:* 6

*Supplies per grade:* Wrapped packages

*Instructions:*

Three students from each grade line up opposite each other at the basketball end lines. Stack the wrapped packages. Carry the stack to their teammate; hand-off to teammate to complete the relay. Students that drop a box must stop to re-stack.

*Scoring:* Order of finish

**Game #5: DELIVER IT. (Area ● )**

*Object:* Deliver the packages in the sleigh

*Number of students per grade:* 4

*Supplies for grade, two per race:*

- Sleigh (maintenance cart)
- 2 Carhart overalls or coats/pants – brown, please
- 2 strands garland (from SPIN IT) tied to form one
- 1 roll ribbon
- wrapped packages (from WRAP IT)
- 1 santa hat
- 1 can shaving cream
- 1 towel (for clean-up)
- 5 cones

*Instructions:*

Two grades race at a time. Two students dress in the Carharts – they are the reindeer who will pull the sleigh. One student ties a bow around themselves as a human package and gets in the sleigh. Santa puts on the cap and uses the shaving cream to make a beard. The packages are added to the sleigh. The garland will be used as the “rope” from Santa, around the reindeer, and back to Santa. Santa weaves the sleigh through the traffic cones the length of the gym, to return to the starting spot. (If time is a problem, we will go just once.)

*Scoring:* Best time wins BUT if students tip the sleigh, they are done. Crashes will be measured for distance based on where the sleigh lands.
