- PVAAS Projections for the following assessments:
 - Projections to Math, ELA and Science(4,8): Students enrolled in grades 4-8
 - Projections to Keystones Algebra I, Literature, Biology: Students enrolled in grade 6 and higher
 - Projections to PSAT: Students enrolled in grades 6-11
 - Projections to ACT, SAT: Students enrolled in grades 9-12
- How to Access PVAAS Student Projections: (<https://pvaas.sas.com>)
 - You can search by Student via "Student Search"
 - You can drill down on the PVAAS Projection Summary Report
 - You can "export" the PVAAS Projections (Export function access provided to district admin account holder)
 - You can make a "Custom Student Report" for YOUR group of students (student level access required).
- Questions to Answer during Analysis:
 - What is the probability that your currently enrolled students will reach the Proficient and/or Advanced level on a future state assessment?
 - Which students may be in need of intervention support? What level of intervention may be needed?
 - Are students who are already on the path to success on these assessments being considered for rigorous coursework?
 - Are there students with a high likelihood of success on these assessments who are not considering a path of advanced placement coursework?
 - Are students who are already on the path to success on these assessments in fact participating in these assessments?
 - Are there students with a high likelihood of success who do not consider themselves as college prepared candidates?

Teacher Specific Data Descriptions

<p>Student Performance on Assessments: This rating represents the percent of the classroom teacher's students at proficient or advanced on the PSSA, PASA or Keystone Exam. The rating is determined using Table H in the regulations (provided for convenience in the help icon below)</p>
<p>Value-Added Assessment System Data: This rating represents the 3 year rolling average PVAAS score. The rating is determined using Table I in the regulations (provided for convenience in the help icon below). A teacher with available PVAAS data shall included at least 10% of this rating to determine his/her final teacher effectiveness rating.</p>
<p>Progress in Meeting Goals of Student IEPs: This rating uses the SLO process to assign a rating to measure progress in meeting the goals of student individualized education plans required under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.</p>
<p>Locally Developed School District Rubrics: This rating uses the SLO process based upon rubrics created by the LEA or an LEA, as a local decision, may select a measure relating to elective data for this rating.</p>
